## Dear Parents/Guardians:

All children entering  $6^{th}$  grade in the State of Illinois are required to have the following:

- 1. A Dental Examination
- 2. A School Physical Examination with the following completed:
  - Diabetes screening
  - Up-To-Date immunizations
  - 4 doses of DTaP with the last dose received on or after the child's 4<sup>th</sup> birthday
  - 2 doses of MMR
  - 4 doses of polio with the last dose received on or after the child's 4<sup>th</sup> birthday
  - 2 doses of varicella (chicken Pox vaccination) or verification of disease by a health care provider
  - 3 doses of Hepatitis B
  - 1 dose of Tdap after age 10
  - One dose Meningococcal Vaccine (meningitis)
  - Parent/Guardian to complete and sign the health history on the back of the health examination report

Appointments for physical examinations after October 15<sup>th</sup> are not acceptable in lieu of physical exam for any students, except for those protected under homeless status. This includes students transferring from out of state; state law provides an extension for vaccinations for out of state transfer students; it does not also provide the same extension for the required health examination.

Any child who has not turned in a completed physical examination form by the first day of school in August may not be able to participate in gym. Completed examination forms should be brought to the school nurse by first day of school.

It is recommended that you keep a copy of your child's examinations at home for your records. If you do not have a copy, please request one from the school when you turn them in.

If you have any questions, please contact the nurse at your child's school.
